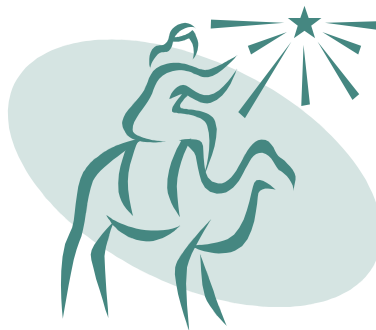
Praises & Prayer Requests
